The areas of traffic marshal/school staff patrol are: Syon Lane, (outside the front entrance), Wood Lane (outside rear pedestrian gates), entrance to Stags Way, Great West Road slip road leading to Leigham Drive. The school promotes safer driving to parents and staff
