The OCR Sports Studies course is broken down into four units, which are examined as follows:

RO52: Developing Sports Skills	Coursework(Marked internally, moderated by OCR)	25	Pupils complete four assignments.
RO54: Sport and the Media	Coursework(Marked internally, moderated by OCR)	25	Pupils complete four assignments.
RO53: Sports Leadership	Coursework(Marked internally, moderated by OCR)	25	Pupils complete four assignments.
