## Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you and your family are safe and well as we continue through another national lockdown. It has only been a week since I wrote to you last and yet much has changed. As a school, we arrived back on January 4<sup>th</sup> with the information that we needed to prepare to become a mass testing centre for all of our pupils and staff; twenty-four hours later, that instruction was off the agenda and we were told, instead, to place all learning on-line.

During the whole Covid-19 period, we have kept up to date with research concerning the most effective methods of deploying remote learning. The Education Endowment Foundation has recently released a summary of research which highlights the fact that a blended approach to remote learning has the potential to be most effective. They state that so long as the quality of teaching is good, a mixture of live lessons, recorded lessons and an opportunity for pupils to develop their independence and resilience by completing work on their own will enable them to make progress.

With that in mind, I wish to update you on our plans for remote learning now that we know that this lockdown will be until at least the end of February. The table below reflects our belief that blended learning is the most judicious use of our resources and also takes into account the circumstances that many of our families find themselves in with regards to the sharing of devices across busy households.
