As you are undoubtedly aware, we are very concerned over the risk from traffic around drop off and pick up times for our children. Having witnessed some of the unsafe driving that occurs, we are worried that there is a substantive risk of harm to some of our school family unless something is done.

As such we would welcome a letter of support from yourselves, as we are going to approach Birmingham Council, in partnership with other local organisations to request some traffic calming measures and safety measures to keep our children and members of our school family safe.

We strongly feel that this is a safety issue, and as part of our safeguarding responsibilities, we would be failing our school values and ethos if we did not seek to address this with the council now.
