Dear Year 2 Parents,

Re: Spelling Frame (spellingframe.co.uk)

We are pleased to invite Year 2 children to a website called Spelling Frame which supports spellings.

Pupils have now received a log in and an example of how to navigate the site has been shared with the children. The details have been stuck into your child's homework book. There are several games they can play as many times as they wish as well as an opportunity to be tested on line to see how well they have secured a particular spelling rule.

Background

Spelling Frame is a website that supports children with spellings from the National Curriculum for Years 2 to 6. All of the statutory and example words are broken down into the same 'spelling rules' that the children are taught in school. Children can log in and choose a spelling rule to practise. When the children practise a spelling rule, each word is read aloud and provided within a sentence for context.

How it works

Children can choose to **practise** a set of words, take a test or play a game with those words. If they choose to practise they will see the word broken down into syllables and will then be given a series of activities to help them to memorise the spelling. The activities develop increasing independence. If the child then spells the word correctly, they move on to the next word. If they make a mistake, they repeat the process to help them to learn the word.

When a child completes the online **test**, they receive instant feedback. If they make a mistake, they are shown the correct spelling and given a series of activities to help them to remember it. Children can attempt the test as many times as they wish to improve their score.

Pupils must complete the spelling test before Monday morning as per other homework. Thank you for your continued support.
