**Update: 2020-21 September Opening**

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that you and your children have enjoyed the summer break thus far. As you are all aware, schools are to open fully in September with a number of precautionary measures in place.

As a school we have continuously reviewed the guidance from the Government as well as taking feedback from the school community. As a result, we have reflected upon our staggered starts and will reduce these from three to two. This will drastically reduce any waiting time siblings may have between drop offs. Due to the high demands on staffing and the strict measures around social distancing we will not be able to make special pick up or drop off arrangements for siblings. If you are in a position where two or more siblings are entering at the same time but at different points, please drop off the elder sibling first (one or two minutes earlier) and then drop the younger sibling off. Teachers and SLT will be on hand to assist at both the rear and front of the school.

Please see the table below to confirm the altered staggered timings for pick up and drop off. Please note this may be different from the previous communication, with any changes highlighted.

We will be operating a one-way system for dropping your children off. Once you have dropped off your child please leave the school premises as quickly as possible in order to help us restrict the number of people on site and refrain from gatherings outside the school site. It is of the utmost importance that children arrive and are picked up on time. If for any reason you arrive late and miss the entrance slot, please wait until 09:15am and then make your way to the office.

**The rear of the school:** If you have been allocated a rear of the school drop off please use the main car park gate to enter. Keep a 2m gap to the family in front of you and bring your child to the drop off point. Once dropped off please exit immediately through the pedestrian gate.

**The front of the school:** Please enter through the main car park gates, keeping a 2m distance bring your child to the drop off point (the class teacher will be waiting in a designated area). Once dropped off please continue through the one-way system and leave via the pedestrian gate.
