Communication and Language

Children will be developing their listening and speaking skills through role play, story time and group activities. Children will be encouraged to listen to others and respond to simple how and why questions.

<u>Literacy</u>

Children will be sharing and discussing a range of stories based on the topic 'All About Me'. Children will also be starting daily phonics sessions, learning new phonemes and exploring how to write letters and initial sounds for words.

Understanding the World

Children will be learning about themselves and their families. We will be talking about the people who are important to us, encouraging children to explore the similarities and differences between families and friends.

Faith Development

Children will be exploring the value of 'Truth'. This is our class name and a very important value. We will be thinking about what 'Truth' means, why it is important and how we can be truthful in our everyday lives.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will be practising turn taking and listening to others ideas through circle time activities. Children will also be learning how to play with others in small groups to complete a task and to respond to what others do or say to keep play going.



Physical Development

Children will be exploring different ways of moving such as hopping, skipping, jumping and sliding. They will be learning to negotiate the space around them by adjusting speed and changing directions.



Mathematics
