As you know SATs are national tests that children take twice during their primary school life. Firstly, at the end of Key Stage 1, in Year 2 (Humility) and then secondly, at the end of Key Stage 2 in Year 6 (Optimism).

The children are working extremely hard in preparing for their assessments and we ask that you continue to support their learning by:

- Ensuring they arrive to school on time
- Where possible to make medical appointments, out of school hours or if necessary towards the end of the school day.
