Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3: Tanglewood at Cannock Chase

This half-term children in year 3 are learning about Plants in Science. To further support their learning, we have organised a visit to Tanglewood Adventure were your child will be able to participate in a 'Habitat Heroes' workshop. The children will discover how the soil and rocks of our woodlands affect how trees and plants survive. They will learn about the uses of tree and rock products and the ways in which the ground beneath benefits us in everyday life. Activities also include creating their very own plaster cast fossil, which they will be able to take home.

This trip will take place on **Tuesday 17**th **March 2020**. The children will need to be in school for the normal start time of 8.45 am, please ensure your child is on time as the coach will leave school at 9.15 am and will return to school for normal dismissal time of 3.30 pm.

On this day the children **will not** need to wear their school uniform and can come to school dressed in suitable outdoor clothing, we suggest long sleeves and trousers and advise children to wear layers of clothing, as these can easily be removed if needed. If your child has wellies or suitable outdoor footwear, please do bring these along on the day in a named carrier bag. Please ensure all other items of clothing are named.

Children will require a packed lunch, please ensure this is in line with our vegetarian policy. The children will be outdoors for most of this trip so healthy snacks and plenty of drinks would be advisable.

As you can appreciate, there are considerable costs involved to arrange such worthy visits, therefore we are asking for a contribution of £12.00. The Education Act of 1988, states that no child can be excluded from a trip due to unaffordability, however, if insufficient funds are not raised then the trip will be unable to go ahead.
