



Milk Entitlement

All reception children will receive a carton of milk each day when they start school. This will remain free until your child turns 5 years of age after which time a small charge would be payable. A letter will be sent to parents to give them the choice of continuing with school milk.

All payments for the school are collected using ParentPay, here a one-off annual charge would be payable for milk, the charge would be calculated from the week that your child turns 5 years to the last day of the academic school year.

For families on low income who are eligible for Free School Meals, milk would continue to be provided for free. Please ensure your admission form includes the parent/carers date of birth and national insurance number, to allow the school to check your child's eligibility.

Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club services

The school offers wrap around care in the form of Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club services, bookings are made via our online ParentPay system, to allow ease of booking and payment. When children start school in Reception their time spent at school will be phased for a couple of days to help with their transitioning. During this time parents will receive their ParentPay login details and will have the opportunity to book wrap around services prior to their child starting full time.

Both services are provided on site with Breakfast Club starting from 7.45am until school starts at 8.45am and Afterschool Club starting from 3.30pm until 5.30pm. Further information will be provided closer to their start date.
