

## Determined - Sixth Form Entry Requirements for September 2027 entry

### A levels

Students applying for Sixth Form at the Nishkam School West London must have secured the EBacc (Standard Pass) along with the following subject specific requirements:

Subject Specific Entry Requirements	
<b>Biology</b>	<p><b>Biology GCSE - Grade 7</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study Biology GCSE, we require</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Combined Science GCSE – Grade 7-7</li> </ul>
<b>Business</b>	<p><b>Business GCSE - Grade 6</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study Business GCSE, we require</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• English Language GCSE – Grade 6</li> </ul>
<b>Chemistry</b>	<p><b>Chemistry GCSE - Grade 7 plus Mathematics GCSE – Grade 7</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study Chemistry GCSE, we require Combined Science GCSE – Grade 7-7</p>
<b>Economics</b>	<p><b>Mathematics GCSE - Grade 7 English Literature GCSE - Grade 7</b></p>
<b>English Literature</b>	<p><b>English Literature GCSE - Grade 6 plus English Language GCSE – Grade 6</b></p>
<b>Geography</b>	<p><b>Geography GCSE - Grade 6</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study Geography GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>
<b>History</b>	<p><b>History GCSE - Grade 6</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study History GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>
<b>Mathematics</b>	<p><b>Mathematics GCSE - Grade 7</b></p>
<b>Further Mathematics</b>	<p><b>Mathematics GCSE – Grade 9</b></p> <p>Further Mathematics A Level <b>must</b> be taken in conjunction with A Level Mathematics</p>

<b>Physics</b>	<p><b>Physics GCSE - Grade 7 plus Mathematics GCSE – Grade 7</b></p> <p>Physics A Level <b>must</b> be taken in conjunction with A Level Mathematics</p> <p>If the applicant did not study Physics GCSE, we require Combined Science GCSE – Grade 7-7</p>
<b>Psychology</b>	<p><b>Psychology GCSE - Grade 6</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study Psychology GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>
<b>Philosophy, Religion and Ethics</b>	<p><b>Religious Studies GCSE - Grade 6</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study Religious Studies GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>
<b>Sociology</b>	<p><b>Sociology GCSE - Grade 6</b></p> <p>If the applicant did not study Sociology GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>

#### **Oversubscription Criteria**

In the event of oversubscription, the following additional criteria will apply for any affected subjects:

**At least a grade 7 in the oversubscribed A level subject**

or an increased requirement of either 7 or 8 or 9 in the associated subjects required for that course

- Conditional offers do not always guarantee the subjects that have been selected by a candidate will be the subjects undertaken at A level. Subjects to be studied are determined by exam results and availability of spaces.
- If a subject has not been studied at GCSE level then it may still be possible for that subject to be taken at A-level. See the individual course requirements for more information.
- The school and its governors reserve the right to reduce curriculum time allocated to a specific course due to low uptake of students and also to withdraw a course due to an extremely low uptake from students.
