Biology	<p>Biology GCSE - Grade 7</p> <p>If the applicant did not study Biology GCSE, we require</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Combined Science GCSE – Grade 7-7
Business	<p>Business GCSE - Grade 6</p> <p>If the applicant did not study Business GCSE, we require</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English Language GCSE – Grade 6
Chemistry	<p>Chemistry GCSE - Grade 7 plus Mathematics GCSE – Grade 7</p> <p>If the applicant did not study Chemistry GCSE, we require Combined Science GCSE – Grade 7-7</p>
Economics	<p>Mathematics GCSE - Grade 7 English Literature GCSE - Grade 7</p>
English Literature	<p>English Literature GCSE - Grade 6 plus English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>
Geography	<p>Geography GCSE - Grade 6</p> <p>If the applicant did not study Geography GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>
History	<p>History GCSE - Grade 6</p> <p>If the applicant did not study History GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6</p>
Mathematics	<p>Mathematics GCSE - Grade 7</p>
Further Mathematics	<p>Mathematics GCSE – Grade 9</p> <p>Further Mathematics A Level must be taken in conjunction with A Level Mathematics</p>
Physics	<p>Physics GCSE - Grade 7 plus Mathematics GCSE – Grade 7</p> <p>Physics A Level must be taken in conjunction with A Level Mathematics</p>

	If the applicant did not study Physics GCSE, we require Combined Science GCSE – Grade 7-7
Psychology	Psychology GCSE - Grade 6 If the applicant did not study Psychology GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6
Philosophy, Religion and Ethics	Religious Studies GCSE - Grade 6 If the applicant did not study Religious Studies GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6
Sociology	Sociology GCSE - Grade 6 If the applicant did not study Sociology GCSE, we require English Language GCSE – Grade 6

Oversubscription Criteria
<p>In the event of oversubscription, the following additional criteria will apply for any affected subjects:</p> <p>At least a grade 7 in the oversubscribed A level subject or an increased requirement of either 7 or 8 or 9 in the associated subjects required for that course</p>

- Conditional offers do not always guarantee the subjects that have been selected by a candidate will be the subjects undertaken at A level. Subjects to be studied are determined by exam results and availability of spaces.
- If a subject has not been studied at GCSE level then it may still be possible for that subject to be taken at A-level. See the individual course requirements for more information.
- The school and its governors reserve the right to reduce curriculum time allocated to a specific course due to low uptake of students and also to withdraw a course due to an extremely low uptake from students.
