Dear parent/carers,

As you may have read or heard the government are re-introducing some tightening of COVID restrictions, in light of the Omicron variant. As a school we have also received some information about school's guidance, detailed below are the key areas that you should be aware of:

Face Masks and Visitors

1. All visitors to school must now wear a face covering;
2. Visitors to the office shall be limited to one family at a time and all adults will be requested to wear a face mask;
3. Please avoid approaching members of staff, use Dojo where possible to communicate.

Travel and Quarantine

1. All adults and children returning from abroad will need to isolate and get a PCR test by 'day two' after arrival. You may end your isolation once you receive a negative result;
2. Positive results must follow isolation guidance;
3. All Red list arrivals will enter the more onerous testing and isolation regime.
