Dear Parent/Carer,

Firstly, may I extend a warm and heartfelt thank you for your support and positivity since our return in August. The children have demonstrated very high levels of diligence and determination towards their learning and your influence on their education is appreciated greatly.

A key element to furthering learning and setting good habits is regularly set and completed homework. As part of our review process we have taken our parent and pupil view into account to ensure we offer homework that is regular, beneficial to learning and manageable for all. We have invested in several IT programmes such as TT RockStars, Sumdog and Reading eggs, to ensure homework is productive and fun. We will be arranging a virtual session for further guidance on the Sumdog platform, details to follow. Below is a breakdown of what to expect each week for your child.

Homework in EYFS is a holistic and flexible approach and includes the following:

- Morning Report (weekly PowerPoints shared) for embedded learning and for parents to access during child absences
- Reading books sent home weekly
- Weekly homework via Dojo for Phonics and Math's
- Topic based homework as appropriate
- Reading Eggs log in to access from home with set assignments
- Relevant website/YouTube links as appropriate
- Theresnoplacelikehomelearning YouTube account access

All activities are once a week unless otherwise stated. Homework will be set on a Friday and needs to be completed before the following Friday, unless otherwise instructed by the class teacher.
