Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are very excited to be launching our one-night residential visit to Entrust Outdoors' Standon Bowers, Education Centre, for a 2-day adventure beginning on the 10th February 2022 and returning on the 11th February 2021.

There are many recognised benefits to be gained from engaging in residential outdoor learning visits. These include personal and social development, independence, team work, confidence and self-esteem, which can be raised and strengthened through fun and challenging group activities, often in new and natural surroundings. Many of these benefits can be transferred back to the classroom and beyond where they can have a real and lasting impact. Working in teams, your child will participate in a number of adventurous activities and sleep in dormitories with friends and with school staff close by.

As the total cost of the visit will depend on the number of children attending (due to transport) we can only confirm the total maximum cost of the trip, which would be £71.00, however once families have paid their deposit and we have met our minimum numbers to go ahead with the trip, we can then inform parents of the actual costs. The cost will include transport, meals, activities and accommodation.

We are confident that this will be a truly memorable and valuable experience for your child and a great opportunity for all our children in Humility 1 and Humility 2 to enjoy an adventure together, creating and sharing memories that can last a lifetime. We wanted to give you plenty of notice, so you can plan and budget for your child's visit. We have been able to reserve enough spaces for all children. We do, however, need to confirm accurate attendance over the coming weeks to finalise our booking. To ensure your child can participate and that the visit can go ahead, we are asking for some commitment from you now and ask for an initial deposit of £20.00 to secure your child's place. Please log onto ParentPay to make your contribution. We ask for parents to complete this by Monday 1st November 2021. This will provide enough time for the school to initially confirm the trip can go ahead as this depends on the uptake, then go through the process of collecting consents, medical forms and advising parents of the 'kit list' (what they will need to bring with them).
