School Summer Uniform

Dear Parent/Carer,

As the Summer Term is due to start we would like to remind parents of our policy on our Summer Uniform. We advise parents to allow their child/ren to wear the summer uniform only if the weather is permitting. We must also remind parents children should come to school with a suitable coat.

Please see below details of the summer uniform your child can wear from the next term:

Girls Summer Uniform

Red Gingham dress (red and white), white socks or white tights, school blazer and/or cardigan and a plain red or white cap/sun hat that should only be worn to provide shade from the sun.

Boys Summer Uniform

Grey school shorts, white shirt (half sleeves if preferred), grey socks, tie, blazer and a plain red or white cap/sun hat that should only be worn to provide shade from the sun.

May I also remind you of the general school uniform:

Girls Uniform

School blazer
School tie
School cardigan/jumper (with logo)
Grey pinafore/trousers/skirt (mid grey)
White shirt
Grey tights/socks and black shoes

Boys Uniform

School blazer
School tie
School jumper (with logo)
Grey trousers
White shirt
Grey socks and black shoes

PE Kit for Girls and Boys

White polo Shirt (with logo) Black jumper (with logo)
Black sports shorts or black track suit bottoms Slip on pumps

All forms of head covering such as a Dastaar, Patka and Hijab should be of a mid-grey colour. Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly named.

Pupils **should not come to** school wearing any of the following:

- Leggings, jeans or skinny trousers
- Boots (above the ankle) or trainers
- Nail colouring or acrylic nails
- Extreme hairstyles (Mohawks and unnatural hair dye colours)

Jewellery

In the interests of safety, pupils should not wear jewellery such as bracelets, necklaces, hooped earrings etc. Articles of faith and small stud earrings may be worn.
