The Eaton Hotel is the perfect place to celebrate the completion of Year 11; it is a stylish venue with a fabulous entrance and private room which will make the Prom 2020 very special indeed.

An evening meal will be provided together with one free drink on arrival, a D.J. will entertain and many more surprises will be revealed throughout the evening. This is a formal event so guests are politely reminded that a formal dress code will be required. A professional photographer will be taking photographs (group and individual) and guests will have the opportunity to purchase these on the evening. The total cost for the evening is £35.00 We know that some pupils will decide to arrange their own transportation, but a mini bus will be available to transfer pupils from school to the venue and back again at no cost (if there is sufficient demand).

To secure a place, a payment of **£35 must be paid by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2020**. - not wear correct uniform throughout the school year.
