The end of year activities day will take place on Thursday, 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020. This will include a number of creative workshops or a school trip. The creative workshops will be a combination of art, music and computing and will be taking place in school free of charge. Numbers are limited for the creative workshops; therefore, it is essential that if you would like your child to take part in them **please reserve your child's place via ParentPay as soon as possible.**

Spaces for the workshops will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis. If you would like your son/daughter to take part in the school trip we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £26.00 to cover the cost for travel and entrance to the theme park. Without a voluntary contribution from each participating student we may have to cancel the trip.

I appreciate that this letter comes to you in the dark and cold month of December and July may seem a million miles away right now, I am however conscious that spreading the cost of trips and events can sometimes make the difference in pupil attendance. In order to reserve your son/daughter's place for their chosen activity make a payment of £5.00 for the trip or reserve a place for the creative workshop on ParentPay **by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2020.**

If you have selected the trip please note that we do not accept any cash payments and all payments need to be made via ParentPay by **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2020.** There are different methods of payment available on ParentPay to enable you to spread the cost. Please see dates below.
