


NST Mission

At Nishkam Schools, our pupils explore the divine context of humanity and wonder of all creation. Faith Development

FD is focused on the virtues, dispositions and attitudes of faith. It is about learning what it is to be human and the virtues that inspire the highest aspirations of humanity. Like RE, it is not focused on a single faith. It intends to deepen both intra-faith and inter-faith understanding promoting the development of a pupils' personal faith in a multi-faith context

Collective Worship

Pupils are supported and encouraged to engage with their own tradition through personal practice, to the extent they deem appropriate. We offer pupils structured and self-guided opportunities within and outside the school timetable to experience their own faith tradition. We collectively deliver assemblies, collective worship, daily prayer, and form exploration time as opportunities to reflect on and deepen individual faith practice.
